Following on from a few queries the Community Housing Strategy officer at RVBC made the following comments

The offer of Community Housing Fund does not supersede the core strategy.

The fund is not necessarily looking at new build.

Sabden has obviously had its share of affordable housing.

The only way we would look at sites not identified in the core strategy is if they are exception sites and 100% affordable developments would fall into this. However this would need to be supported with Housing Needs evidence.

Councillors agreed not to pursue this at this time.

A Padiham Road resident expressed concerns regarding the number of vehicles parking on double yellow lines and on the pavement along Padiham Road.
